

IN A SAFE ENVIRONMENT

notruf is an advice centre for people aged sixteen and over who have experienced sexualised violence.

Here, they can talk to someone about what they have experienced in a **safe environment**, **at their own pace** and **completely free of charge**. Other aspects, for example with regard to the prosecution of the offence or therapy offers, can also be discussed during the appointment.

- We offer advice regardless of whether the abuse experienced was physical or mental, experienced in person or digitally, recently or already some time ago.
- All people of all genders (women, men, divers) can turn to **notruf.**
- Relatives or friends of someone who has experienced sexualised violence can also make use of our offer.
- They will receive advice from psychologists who are experienced in counselling sexually traumatised people and have a duty to maintain confidentiality.

CONFIDENTIAL COLLECTION OF FORENSIC EVIDENCE

Those affected of a sexual crime are in a difficult situation, both mentally and physically.

Due to the abuse you have experienced, you may not feel able to make a decision with regard to reporting the crime straight away. The confidential collection of forensic evidence gives you the option of having **medical evidence of the crime** preserved in a way that will stand up in court as evidence if you decide to report the crime later on.
